- **Growth charts**
- **Immunization records**
- **Any related diagnostic imaging**
- **Recent lab work**
- **Specific questions and concerns about patient who is being referred**

Our specialists are certified by the American Board of Allergy and Immunology. We partner with specialists from Hasbro Children’s Hospital and Rhode Island Hospital to ensure that all patients receive appropriate, comprehensive care. We work with patients and their families to provide individualized treatment and education that will help them manage the child’s illness and increase their well-being.

Allergy and immunology disorders diagnosed, evaluated and treated include:

- Allergic rhinoconjunctivitis
- Adverse drug reactions
- Anaphylaxis
- Asthma
- Atopic dermatitis (eczema)
- Contact dermatitis
- Food allergy
- Immunodeficiency
- Mastocytosis/mast cell disorders
- Eosinophil disorders
- Urticaria/angioedema
- Stinging insect reactions

Testing and therapeutic interventions include:

- Skin testing to food, medication
- Patch skin testing to chemicals
- Allergen immunotherapy
- Insect venom immunotherapy
- Desensitization to medications
- Monoclonal antibody therapy

Provider can call to get information; however, guardian must call to place child on the waitlist.

Partial Hospital Program Referral Process

Intake coordinator collaborating with nurse manager, peds and psych co-directors

- a. Receive initial referrals from broad range of sources:
 - i. Providers including PMDs, medical specialists, psych providers, other inpatient services
 - ii. Families
 - iii. Other services: DCYF, courts, schools
- b. Information required for consideration
 - i. Intake form (see pages 22-25) if requested (complex patients, those without sufficient records in Hasbro chart)
 - ii. Pertinent medical records
 - iii. Assessment of appropriateness for treatment
 1. Patient presentation has physical and emotional components
 2. Acuity matches level of care
 3. Presence of functional impairment
 - iv. Assessment of patient and family readiness for treatment
 1. Patient and family understanding of factors contributing to presentation
 2. Openness to integrated, family-based treatment
 3. Family availability for involvement in treatment
 4. Considering objective factors as well as your “gestalt”
 5. Pre-admission meetings with team and patient/family can be helpful
